

#### Cases surge at state facility

31 more diagnosed at Denton living center for people with disabilities

ed 31 new cases of novel core navirus at the Denton State Supported Living Center on Priday, a dramatic surger in a population that is especially ulnerable to the virus.

There are now 39 reported cases of COVID-19 at the center, which employs over LAOC warkers and is borns to nearly 450 people with intellectual and developmental disabilities. "This is appending we are both very concerned about but very presentive about," Gos Greg Abbert said Priday during an interview on KXAS-TV (NBC6). Kits were organized and instructions were sent home with parents to guide at home studio set-up. We learned that **over-communication** was key.


Oil and Cotton teachers worked together to pull "props" from the studio to recreate the feeling and aesthetic of the Oil and Cotton studio at home.
